
POST-COMMUNION PRAYER

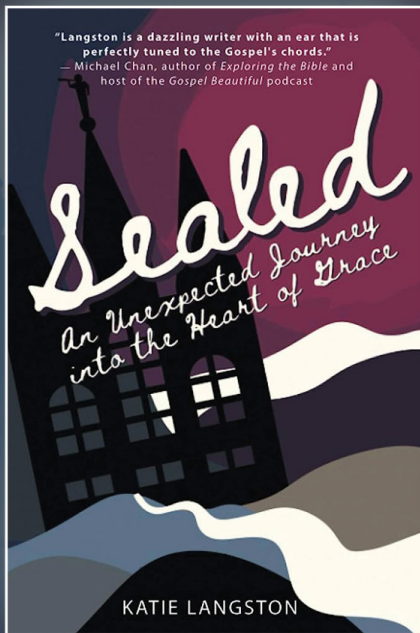
