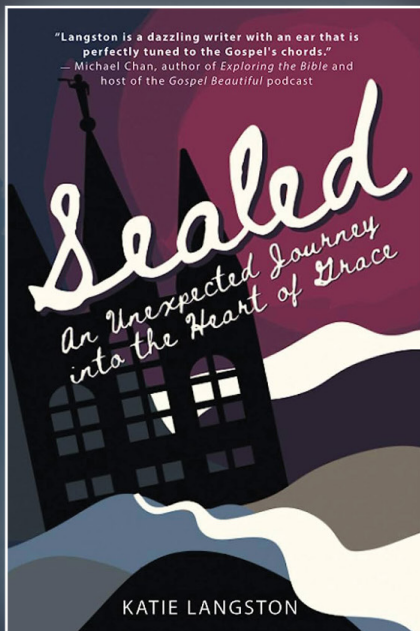

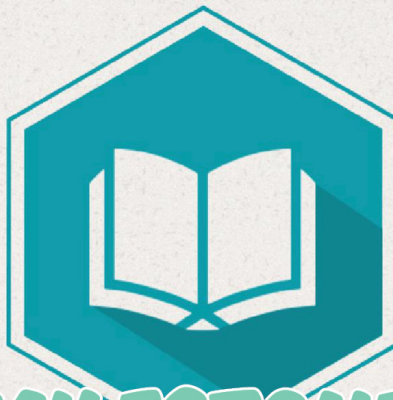


3rd Grade Bible Class

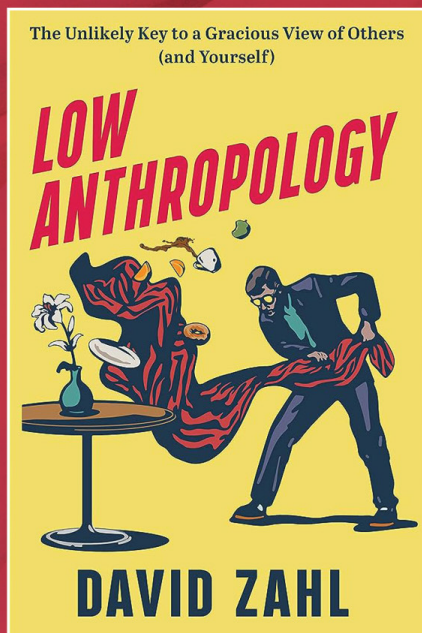

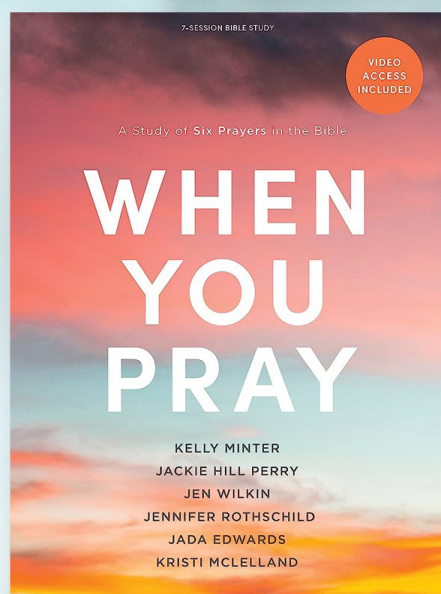
